### Looking Forward...

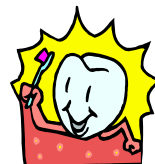

Encourage your child to find the first letter of his/her name, a color, a shape, or a certain picture and your wait may be less stressful and your child may learn and have fun.



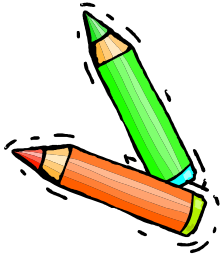

### Reminder....

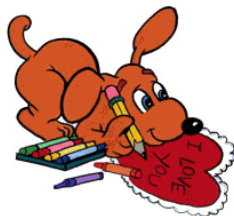

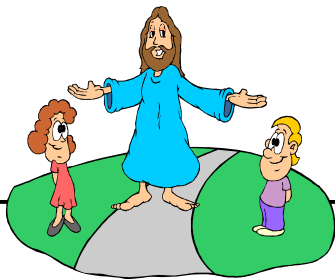


## Important News
