Looking Forward...

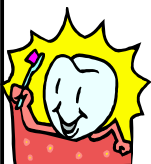
February is a short month and will review our colors and letters We will also explore spatial relationship such as inside/ outside, near/far, under/over, up/down, etc.

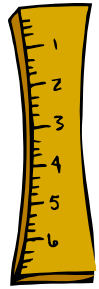
IN HOUSE FIELD TRIP

Reminder....

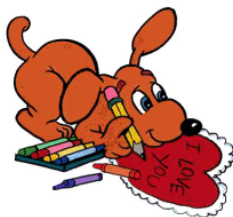

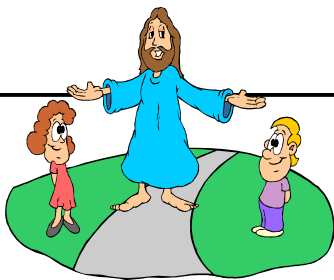


Important News
